


ROCHESTER HOPE FOR PETS

Mission:

ROCHESTER HOPE FOR PETS' MISSION IS THREEFOLD: IMPROVING THE QUALITY OF LIFE FOR ROCHESTER AREA COMPANION ANIMALS BY PROVIDING GRANTS FOR VETERINARY CARE TO PETS WHOSE OWNERS ARE IN TIMES OF NEED; ASSISTING VETERINARY HEALTH TEAMS WITH CONTINUING EDUCATION, RESEARCH, AND NEW TECHNOLOGY FOR THE ADVANCEMENT OF COMPANION ANIMAL CARE; AND PROVIDING SUPPORT TO ANIMAL-RELATED NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS WHOSE MISSIONS SUPPORT HOMELESS ANIMALS IN NEED.

History:

IN 2008, A JACK RUSSELL TERRIER WAS PICKED UP BY ANIMAL CONTROL IN ROCHESTER, NY. DESPITE HER POOR CONDITION, THE LITTLE TERRIER'S SPUNK AND VIGOR INSPIRED THE VETERINARIANS AND STAFF AT THE ANIMAL HOSPITAL OF PITTSFORD, WHO DONATED THE CARE AND SERVICES NEEDED TO HEAL THE DOG AND GIVE HER A SECOND CHANCE AT LIFE. THE HOSPITAL STAFF DUBBED THE LITTLE DOG "HOPE," AND HELPED HER FIND A HOME ONCE SHE WAS HEALTHY. HER SUCCESS STORY INSPIRED THE SHAREHOLDERS OF MONROE VETERINARY ASSOCIATES TO ENVISION A FOUNDATION THAT COULD ASSIST OTHER PETS IN THE ROCHESTER AREA. THIS VISION WAS REALIZED WITH THE CREATION OF THE MVA HOPE FOUNDATION IN 2008. IN 2012, THE ORGANIZATION WAS RENAMED ROCHESTER HOPE FOR PETS.

Wyatt's Tail of Hope:



BECKY AND HER HUSBAND ADOPTED WYATT FROM A LOCAL SHELTER WHEN HE WAS JUST A KITTEN. THIS FALL, HE SNUCK OUTSIDE AND CAME BACK WITH AN INJURY ON HIS FOOT. IT BECAME INFECTED, AND EVEN WITH ANTIBIOTICS, IT JUST WOULDN'T HEAL. AN X-RAY REVEALED THAT WYATT HAD DEVELOPED OSTEOMYELITIS — THE INFECTION HAD SPREAD TO THE BONE. WYATT, ALWAYS A SWEET, LOVING CAT, WAS IN SO MUCH PAIN. ON TOP OF THIS, BECKY'S HUSBAND HAD RECENTLY SUFFERED A STROKE AND NOW REQUIRED AROUND-THE-CLOCK CARE. THEY WENT FROM TWO INCOMES TO JUST ONE, AND WERE STRUGGLING TO KEEP UP WITH THE MOUNTING VET BILLS. WHEN THEIR VET TOLD THEM WYATT NEEDED TO HAVE THE INFECTED TOE AMPUTATED, BECKY DIDN'T KNOW HOW

SHE WAS GOING TO PAY. SHE APPLIED TO ROCHESTER HOPE FOR PETS, AND BECAUSE OF YOUR DONATIONS, WE WERE ABLE TO HELP BECKY PAY FOR WYATT'S SURGERY. TODAY, HE'S RUNNING AROUND AND ACTING LIKE A KITTEN AGAIN — THE VET SAYS HE'LL MAKE A FULL RECOVERY. BECKY SAYS, "THANK YOU FOR THE BEST CHRISTMAS GIFT I COULD HAVE GOTTEN...MY KITTY IS FEELING BETTER AGAIN! I WILL ALWAYS REMEMBER THE GENEROSITY OF THE PEOPLE WHO DONATED TO MAKE THIS POSSIBLE!"

PETS RECEIVED NEEDED VETERINARY CARE BECAUSE OF YOUR DONATIONS.

AWARDS FOR VETERINARY CARE WERE USED AT 49 LOCAL HOSPITALS, AND TOTALED \$100,276.



FERAL CATS WERE SPAYED/NEUTERED, VACCINATED, AND RETURNED TO THEIR HABITAT, IMPROVING THE HEALTH OF ROCHESTER AREA NEIGHBORHOOD CATS AND PREVENTING OVERPOPULATION.




AWARDED FROM DUNCAN'S FUND FOR VETERINARY EDUCATION.
